

2. The user has a view of all the properties. Each property, for easier identification, shows a picture and a description (Address and type of report).
3. Clicking on the "Add Property" icon allows the user to start the process of adding a property.
4. Clicking on "Change View" lets the user displays a different view of the properties, for instance one column view.
5. In addition, users can sort the properties based on "Created Date" or "Property Name". This allows the user to quickly find a property.

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

6. "Add a Property" loads on the middle of the screen with the following required fields:
 - Property Name
 - Address
 - City
 - Zip
 - Estate
7. Allowing the user to link to a map application simplifies entering an address.

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

8. A clickable empty square shows that a new property has been created. At this point there is no more information that describes the property than its address.
The new property is added chronologically.

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

9. In the "Property Details" window, users can add or edit information. At this point, the user cannot see any picture associated to the property because she/he has not uploaded any.
10. Clicking on "Place an Order" will redirect the user to the ordering page. Also, users can access old reports associated to the property when clicking on the report icon.
11. Text boxes allow the user to update any data regarding the property. However, "ID", "Products", and "Last Activity" are labels that users cannot update because they are unique identifiers.
12. The map provides a visual aid to the user. She/he can verify addresses.
13. Clicking on "Add Photo" allows the user to upload pictures.
14. The "Search Address" located on the right corner of the window, allows users to search for any property address.

14. Clicking on one of the pictures, a modal window opens.
16. The modal window contains several features. Some features include adding effects, captions or drawing.
17. Clicking on "My Properties" (bread crum) allows the user to return to the previous page.
